This is with reference to an ISO programme for youth to participate in advancing critical standards for sustainable development. The programme is related to activities carried out by the ISO Technical Committee on Environmental Management (ISO/TC 207), which develops standards in the field of environmental management that are necessary to address environmental and climate impact, thus supporting sustainable development. The ISO Environmental Management Committee is seeking young people interested in sustainability issues and environmental progress through standardization, to establish a Youth Leadership Group.
