About the Host Institution: In 1960, the first agricultural university of India, UP Agricultural University, came into being by an Act of legislation, UP Act XI-V of 1958. The University was rechristened as Govind Ballabh Pant University of Agriculture and Technology keeping in view the contributions of Pt. Govind Ballabh Pant, the then Chief Minister of UP. The university was dedicated to the nation by the first Prime Minister of India, Pt Jawaharlal Nehru on 17 November 1960. The G.B. Pant University, the harbinger of green revolution in our country, is a symbol of successful partnership between India and the United States. The establishment of this university brought about a revolution in agricultural education, research, and extension. It paved the way for setting up of 31 other agricultural universities in the country. University has various colleges, namely College of Basic Sciences and Humanities, College of Agriculture, College of Agribusiness Management, College of Fisheries, College of Home Science, College of Technology and College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences.

Pantnagar, the main campus lies in Udham Singh Nagar district of Uttarakhand at 29° N latitude and 79° E longitude at an elevation of 243.8 m above the mean sea level. This main campus has the area responsibility for the entire Uttarakhand representing plains, Tarai, Bhabar and hill areas.

About the Department: The Department of Biochemistry is one of the premier departments of University and is engaged in teaching and research in the area of plant sciences and offers degree in Biochemistry at Master's and Ph.D. level. The Department has got excellent infrastructure in the areas of secondary metabolites, natural products, enzymology, bioenergy and plant tissue culture etc. From time to time, department had funding from different agencies of India.

About the Conference: The Indian Himalayan region spread across various states is endowed with rich biodiversity of plants due to their various ecological locations and altitudinal variation within a short distance. About 85 % of the Himalayan population is directly or indirectly dependent on traditionally practiced integrated hill agriculture, animal husbandry and

agro-forestry for livelihood. Millets form an integral part of subsistence agriculture in Himalayan region predominated by small farmers. Millets are used for food and fodder.
